Regarding District Technical Officials Seminar cum Examination

RSFI (INDIA SKATE) – Roller Skating Federation of India (INDIA SKATE) is going to conduct District Level Technical Officials Online Seminar cum Examination from 6th to 27th of February 2022.

This Examination aims to educate and create awareness on the Competition and Technical Rules among all the stakeholders interested in Roller Skating officiating at the grass-root level, which will be very helpful for the District Roller Skating Associations to conduct their Championships. The details of the registration are given below:

Start Date of Registration – January 01, 2022 (Midnight)

End Date of Registration - February 01, 2022 (Midnight)

Minimum Qualification - Matriculation/10th Pass.

Registration Fee - INR 1000/-

Date of Course - 6-27 February 2022 (every Sunday on Zoom)

Interaction with lecturers - 6-27 February 2022 (Sunday 11.00hrs to 14.00 hrs.)

Date of Examination - February 27 2022 (13:00 hrs. to 15:00 hrs.)

Registration Link: Available on RSFI Website (www.indiaskate.com)

Zoom classroom links will be provided to the registered candidates on the lecture day.

Eligibility:

Persons recommended by the State/U.T Association recognized by District Units only would be permitted to enroll. The recommended list may include names of existing

T.O. as well as new entrants. The eligibility criteria for new entrants are that they should be active in respective Roller Sports and above 21 years of age.

Educational Qualification: Minimum Matriculation/10th Pass

Roller Skating Achievements: District participant or any person having experience of 5 years and more in District Championships as of 01.01.2022 may be exempted from the above educational qualification criteria. However, The decision of RSFI will be final and binding on all.

-Classes will be held simultaneously.

-The eligible candidates will be permitted to attend only one discipline in which they have participated.

-Medium of Instruction: English & Hindi.

-All qualified judges will be given an RSFI certificate, I.D. card & set of rules.

-The Certificates will entitle the T.O. to attend District level competitions.

Coaching Certification Levels: Only Qualified for the Examination will be awarded a District Level T.O certificate valid for one year and is renewable. Candidates must secure 60% and above to qualify. Candidates failing to be eligible/qualify shall retake the Examination.

Annual Fees: All District Level T.O should renew every year on payment of Rs. 500/- or as decided by the RSFI Executive Committee from time to time,

Conditions: After obtaining the certificate as T.O. from RSFI, that person is not permitted to participate in any competition as a skater or attend as T.O. in any event that RSFI does not approve. If a person takes part in any such event as a T.O., his accreditation and certificate as T.O. will stand cancelled.

RSFI will conduct an Examination after the training programme. Examination Format

The candidates who get a 60% score will be declared 'Pass',

All the District Roller Skating Associations must ensure that only qualified persons are appointed as Technical Officials for their District Skating Championships. Candidates who have qualified for the DTO examination are only eligible to appear for the next level of Examination 'Federation State Technical Officials [FSTO]' Examination and shall be considered for appointment in State and National Championships Technical Officials.

There will be classes on officiating various Roller Skating disciplines for two and a half hours during the four classes. It will be handled by eminent and well-experienced lecturers and technical officials who have officiated on several National and International Competitions, including Asian Games & Asian Championships. It will be bilingual, that is, English and Hindi used simultaneously. An interaction session to clarify doubts will follow the session, and examination will be held online..

The aim is to help promote Roller skating and ensure a proper, foolproof and perfect technical Support to conduct District Championships. All the State Roller Skating Association Secretaries should take this matter very seriously.

Ensure participation from every district in your state since there are many possibility for improvement in the technical conduct of Roller Skating Competitions at the grassroots level. You may convene a meeting with the secretaries of your district units to elaborate this and give maximum publicity through the press and social media and ensure that this information reaches every interested person.
