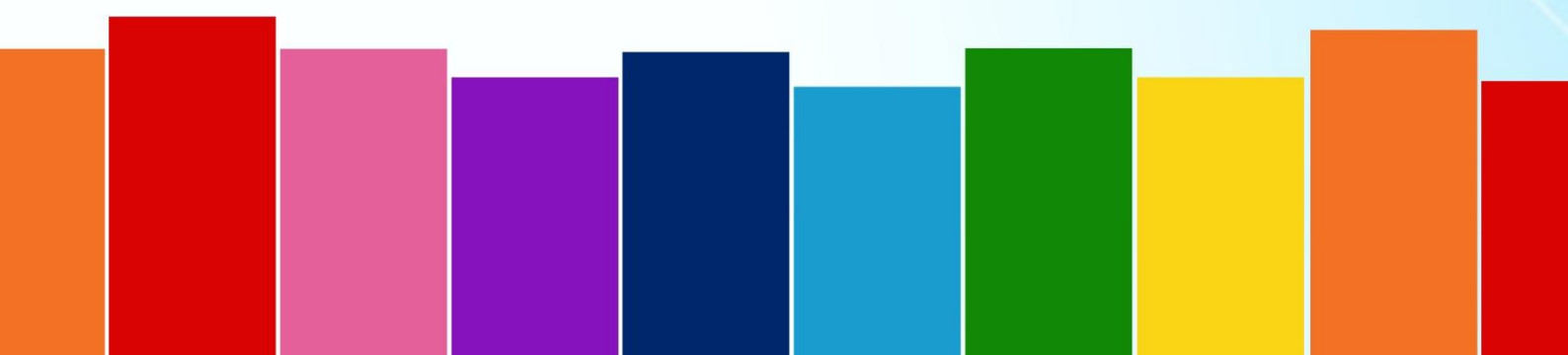

### Important Notes:-

- Any No. of skaters allowed to register in each Age Group in Quad and Inline races from each State/U.T. in both Boys and Girls.
- Cadet skaters (Quad and Inline) of the age group 5 - 7 years Boys & girls can take part in 2 out of the 3 races, (Quad and Inline) skaters of the age group 07 - 09 and 09 - 11 years Boys & Girls, can take part in 3 out of 4 races.
- Quad skater of Age Group 11-14, 14-17 & Above 17 years can take part in maximum 3 out of the 4 races.
- Inline skaters of the Age Group 11 - 14, 14 - 17, and Above 17 can take part in 3 out of the 5 Inline races
- Only Inline skaters of 35 years and above can take part in MASTERS. Each skater can take part in 2 out of the 3 races.
- Skaters who had taken part in any of the previous National Championship only are allowed to take part in Master Age Group.
- Inline skaters are not allowed to take part in Quads races similarly Quad skaters are not allowed to take part in Inline Races.
- Speed Technical Committee General Regulations and Updated World Skate (FIRS) Speed Skating rules Shall be followed for conducting all races.
- For other details please refer to General Rules for Speed Skating 2019.

**ROLLER HOCKEY & INLINE HOCKEY-** As per the ISRG Guidelines a Team can now be formed of 10 players i.e. 8 Players and 2 Goalkeepers (However there must be minimum 2 Goalkeepers and 4 Players in a team to be eligible for it to play a match). For team discipline i.e. Inline Hockey, Roller Hockey & Roller Derby, Clubs which are affiliated to the District Association or District Association affiliated to the State/U.T Association or State/U.T Association affiliated to RSFI can field teams.

**ROLLER DERBY:** In Roller Derby there will be only one age group & one category (10 Girls)

### ARTISTIC SKATING

- Dance - Solo and Couple
- Free Skating - Quad and Inline
- Pair Skating
- Quartet.

Skaters can participate in any three out of the five artistic events. In artistic skater has to choose either Quad or Inline. The same skater cannot participate in both events.

**INLINE FREESTYLE SKATING** - Classic and speed events

A). **Entry Fee: Rs.750/-**

B). **Venue : Rink** – URSC, Delpur, Mohali, Punjab.

C). **Rink availability for practice prior to the championship: Two Days free for all skaters.**

**1. The Games** will be held as per RSFI rules and will be conducted by Technical Officials of RSFI.

**2. Entry:** The 1<sup>st</sup> INDIA SKATE ROLLER GAMES 2022 Entry to be done online. Please go to the website [www.indiaskate.com](http://www.indiaskate.com) Register and login with the password. Fill up entry carefully, scan the Photo & E- aadhar/aadhar upload . After completing & uploading all the Entries online, take a printout of the entries. One copy of the hard copy of Entry to be submitted to the Championship Committee office. **All the entries are subject to the approval / clearance of respective State/U.T. Association.**

**Registration – 1st INDIA SKATE ROLLER GAMES Registration will open 5<sup>th</sup> February 2022.**

**For individual events, any number of skaters may be registered in each age group from each State/U.T.**

**3. Eligibility:** RSFI Registered Skaters for **2022-23** only are eligible to participate. A skater should be 5 years of age as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022.to be eligible for participation in their respective age group.

**4. Protest:** as per RSFI rules the Protest Fee of Rs.3,000/- shall be enclosed along with every written protest made to the Chief Referee. The protest must be made by the skater/Manager within 15 minutes before or after completion of the event. Depending on availability of time and concerned records the Technical Committee/PRSA/RSFI will decide the matter. In case the protest is upheld the fee will be returned. No protest/claim shall be entertained from the Coaches/Parents. Protests shall be accepted only from the concerned Team Manager/s whose name appears in the Entry Form furnished by the State/UT association/s. On appeal, the Verdict/decision of the Jury of Appeal, at any level, shall be final and binding on one and all.

**5. Minimum Participation :** In an age group, even if there is only one participant, the event will be held. However medals will be given on the basis of Minimum criteria rules only.

**6. Liability:** Please note that for any injury/losses caused to the participants during the above Tournament, on or off the skating/playing area, PRSA/RSFI shall not be responsible and or liable to meet any expenses/damages whatsoever. Therefore all participating skaters are to take adequate accidental, medical and life insurance policies. They are to carry the necessary policies with themselves.

**7. UNIFORM/EQUIPMENTS:** Skaters have to come in proper uniform and with proper equipment for the all events. Helmet (Headgear) is compulsory.

**8.** In case of any unforeseen circumstances if the schedule of events is not completed, the decision by RSFI observer and PRSA will be final.

**GENERAL:**

**(i).**Skaters/s who are under suspension or have disciplinary action pending against them, shall not be eligible to participate in the GAMES.

**(ii).**Skaters are to bring wheels suitable for use on all kind of floors including Asphalt/ Asphalt Coated, Cement - Kota - Cudappa Stone - Tandur Stone - Mosaic - Tarmac - Wooden surfaces etc.

**(iii).**To uplift the standard of skating and face challenges of international competitions and to discourage substandard skaters, Judges and referees at the GAMES may introduce Elimination round/ Qualifying Time/ Points /Marks/ Conduct Skating tests for allowing participation in the Nationals. Skaters found sub- standard will not be allowed participation. e.g. All Hockey players must perform skating and basic hockey skill at the start of Hockey match before National referee/s. If the skater is found substandard then he/she will not be eligible to participate.

**(iv).**It is suggested that the U.T/State Associations appoint a Lady official for the Girls team and also a Physio or any medical attendant for the team players.

The Team Manager appointed for the U.T/State team should be able to maintain a code of conduct during the National Championship, as we have seen in past, inappropriate conduct towards judges, officials, Organizers and other participants Parents & coaches of the skaters.

In case of unacceptable behaviors, the concerned athlete will be liable of facing a penalty & disqualification.

**(v). Disrespectful** (e.g. sexual, violent, insulting) movements or gestures, especially towards the judges or during Opening/Closing/Medal ceremony, are not appropriate and the skater can be penalized or disqualified.

Medal winners not present during the medal ceremony will not be awarded the medal and action will be initiated. The may be a penalised with a fine of Rs. 1000 for individual event and Rs. 10000/- for a team event or Suspension from participating in the next championship or both.

**(vi).Dope/Drug Test:** may be carried out at random on players to ensure drug/ dope are not used by them to enhance performance. Anti Doping Rules of NADA is applicable to all participants. Please see RSFI website in this regard. All Skaters shall be ready any time for Dope Test.

Anti Doping Rules of National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) is applicable to all participants. The players can be medically examined by the concerned agencies or any other agency advised by the government PRSA/RSFI/WS/WSA at any point of time. The PRSA/RSFI may ask for necessary medical certificate/s in this regard from any player at any point of time. Expenses if any in this regard are to be borne by the concerned skater/s.

**(vii).Managers/Coaches Meeting:** will be held between 5 to 7 p.m. on the day of reporting to discuss arrangements made for The Championships/ Clarification of Rules/ Announcement of program/ and the Championship Schedule etc. Respective RSFI Technical Committees proposes to conduct clinics for participating team coaches/managers.

**(viii).Accident/Medical/Life/Insurance Policies:** Please note that for any injuries/losses caused to Participants/Officials /accompanying members during Championships/ on or off the playing area, RSFI and or Organizers/ Host Association and or its officials shall not be responsible and or liable to meet any expenses/ damages whatsoever. All the participating skaters, officials and accompanying members must take adequate accidental, medical and life insurance policies. They are to carry the necessary policies with themselves. Every team must carry First Aid Kit.

**(xi).Force Majure:** In case of any unforeseen circumstances if daily schedule is changed and or events remain incomplete, decision taken by the Federation's Technical Committee shall be final and binding on all the teams.
