General Information:

01. Inauguration of the All India Inter-University Roller Sports (Men & Women), Roller Hockey (Men & Women) & Inline Hockey Tournaments on **30/06/2022**. All the participating universities are requested to take part in the inauguration with their University flags.
02. Participating Universities are requested to inform their travel schedule to the organizing Secretary well in advance so as to arrange accommodation.
03. Managers meeting will be held on **29.06.2022 at 4.00 pm**. All the Managers are requested to attend the meeting along with 4 sets of eligibility forms containing attested copies of X, +2 in case of UG and X, +2 and Degree certificates in case of PG students and ID cards duly attested by the competent authorities, without fail.
04. The schedules of matches/events are subject to alternation and the same shall be intimated one day in advance.
05. The teams should be present 30 minutes before the start of the match/event.
06. Team Managers are totally responsible for their players' discipline during competition and stay.
07. The teams will be provided unfurnished accommodation one day earlier to the commencement of their respective matches and the teams are expected to vacate within 24 hours after losing their match.
08. Officiating fee will be collected as per AIU guidelines.
09. A caution deposit of **Rs.1000/-** will be collected from the Managers at their lodging place. This amount will be refunded at the time of check out with deductions if any, in respect of damages, etc.
10. The teams shall produce their players ID cards whenever asked for.
11. The decision of the Organizing Committee of the tournament shall be the final and binding in all the matters concerned.
12. The Organizing Secretary reserves the right to make changes (to advance, Postpone or to alter) the tournament/events program, if any, as and when required, However, prior intimation will be given to the managers while affecting such changes.
13. The defaulting universities for having not paid the subscription to AIU, for the year 2021-22, will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.
14. 'SEA' in Visakhapatnam Vicinity is very dangerous. Managers are advised to pass strict instructions to the players that not to venture into sea.

General Information & stipulations

Dates and Venue for Championship :- All the disciplines will be conducted from 30th June to 3rd July 2022 at Andhra University & VMRDA PARK .

Organized by: Andhra University in association with Andhra Pradesh Roller Skating Association with the support of Visakhapatnam District Roller Sports Association .

Events:

(1).Speed Skating:

Maximum Skaters allowed from each University in Men & Women are 24 each (24 Men & 24 Women).

Distances for six Inline Speed Skating Races:

Road Race 1	100 Meters Sprint	Track Race 1	500+D Meters
Road Race 2	1 Lap Sprint	Track Race 2	1000 Meters Sprint
Road Race 3	10000 Meters Point Race	Track Race 3	10000 Meters Points + Elimination.

Note: From each University, a skater can take part in a maximum 3 out of 6 races with not more than four skaters taking part in each race.

Road Race:

(i).100Meters Sprint:

It is a race on 100m straight road. During the first round, only best times are qualified. The following rounds, the winners of the heat accede directly to the next round and the other skaters are qualified according to the best times in the heats. The final is run by 2 or 3.

(ii). One lap sprint race:

On the road circuit, One Lap race, the distance shall be between 250 meters and 600 metres.

Organisation of the race

First Round Qualification of the best sixteen (16) times. **(Not more than 6 skaters in each heat)**

Quarter Final, Semi Final and Final are organized according to the following table. If the 16th and 17th position skater cannot be decided then the quarters final are raced with seventeen (17) skaters.

The Quarter series 1 will be raced with 5 skaters. **(17th Skater will race in QF - 1).**

(iii).10000 Meters Point Race: This race awards a score for each skater after each fixed point of the course. At the completion of the last lap a greater score will be awarded. The skater totaling the highest number of points wins the race.

Track Race:

(ii) 500 m +D

The distance of race is 2.5 laps (500m) plus the Distance resulting to the middle of the straightaway, thus the start line will be in the middle of the straightaway.

Organisation of the race

First Round Qualification of the best sixteen (16) times. **(Not more than 6 skaters in each heat)**

Quarter Final, Semi Final and Final are organized according to the following table.

If the 16th and 17th position skater cannot be decided then the quarters final are raced with

seventeen (17) skaters. The Quarter series 1 will be raced with 5 skaters. **(17th Skater will race in QF - 1).**

(iii) **1.000m sprint race**

It is a speed tournament with a maximum of 3 rounds. Only the winners of the heat accede directly to the next round. The others skaters are qualified according to the best times in the heats. The final is run, by the winner of each semi-final and the best loser times, for a total of eight skaters.

10000 Meters Points + Elimination Race

This race is a combination of the elimination and points races. It consists in eliminating the last skater or the last skaters and in assigning points to the first two (2) skaters at certain laps. The winner of this race will be the one who, having run the whole course, has accumulated the greatest score.

Racing Suit: All skaters of the same University must wear the same uniform with long or short sleeves with the University Colour.

Helmet: The helmet must be well fastened on the head. A skater who removes his/her helmet before the end of the race shall be disqualified.

Skates:

1. Skates having a maximum of five (5) wheels, fastened in line, or skates with two pairs of wheels fastened parallel to each other are permitted. The skate must not exceed fifty (50) centimetres in length. Skates must be firmly attached to the shoes and axles are not to protrude from the wheels. Brakes are forbidden.
2. The maximum diameter of wheel must not exceed hundred and ten (110) millimetres.

(2).Roller Hockey (12 Men & 12 Women):

A participating team must comprise of minimum 6 players i.e. 2 Goal Keeper, 4 players and a compulsory substitute Goal Keeper and play at least one match then only the ranking will be done. Team participation will be subject to there being at-least 2 teams in the concerned championships and play at least one match the ranking will be done.

(3).Inline Hockey (12 Men & 12 Women):

A participating team must comprise of minimum 8 players i.e. 2 Goal Keeper, 4 players and 1 compulsory substitute Goal Keeper, 2 substitute players and play at least 1 match then only ranking will be done. Team participation will be subject to there being at least 2 teams in the concerned championships and play at least one match the ranking will be done.

(4).Artistic Skating:-

Maximum Skaters allowed from each University in Men & Women are 4 each (4 Men & Women). Event: Free Skating & Solo Dance (quad).

For Free Skating & dance (Quad) a skater to claim a Gold Medal must first score an average of 6 out of 10 marks, for Silver 5.5 out of 10 mark, for Bronze 5 out of 10 marks. The medals will be given thereafter subject to their ranking. Till unless there are common, Joint winners will not be declared. For example if no one gets 6 marks and above, the person getting say between 5.9 to 5.5 marks will get Silver and one getting less than the said person will get bronze only. Others below them will not get any medals

Note: From each University, four Men & four Women skaters can take part in Free Skating & Solo dance event.

(5).Inline Freestyle Skating: Maximum Skaters allowed from each University in Men & Women are 4 each (4 Men & 4 Women). Event: Inline Speed Slalom. Inline Speed Slalom is about dashing and weaving through a line of cones placed at intervals. The whole objective is to complete the line of cones as fast as possible.

Note: From each University, four Men & four Women skaters can take part in Inline Speed Slalom event.

(6).Skateboarding: Maximum Skaters allowed from each University in Men & Women are 4 each(4 Men & 4 Women).Event: Half Pipe. A participant must score at least an average of 60% marks to get a Gold Medal, for Silver Medal an average of 55% marks and for Bronze Medal an average of 50% marks.

Note: From each University, four Men & four women skaters can take part in street event.

General Rules;

(i).Skaters can participate in any discipline i.e. In Speed Skating or Artistic Skating or Roller Hockey or Inline Hockey or Skateboarding.

(ii).Skaters are to bring wheels suitable for use on all kind of floors including Asphalt/ Asphalt Coated, Cement – Kota – Cudappa Stone - Tandur Stone – Mosaic – Tarmac – Wooden-Road surfaces etc..

(iii) All rules and regulations of RSFI shall be applicable.
