We are happy to inform that the 3rd INDIA SKATE GAMES 2026 is scheduled to be held from 23rd to 28th April 2026 at (Chandigarh) organised by Chandigarh Roller Skating Association under the aegis of Roller Skating Federation of India (INDIA SKATE) as follows:

1. Disciplines, Schedule & Venue

Roller Hockey, Inline Hockey, Roller Derby, Alpine & Downhill

-Reporting on 22nd April, events will be held from 23rd to 28th April & 29th reserve day, departure on 30th April 2026.

Roller & Inline Hockey Events:

Multiple teams are allowed from every state.

Roller Hockey – Minimum 6 Players (4 players + 2 Goal Keepers)

Max 10 Players (8 Players + 2 Goal Keepers)

Inline Hockey – Minimum 6 Players (4 players + 2 Goal Keepers)

Max 12 Players (10 Players + 2 Goal Keepers)

3. Entry Fee: Rs.750 /- per head. – Should be paid online on indiaskate.com portal.

Rink availability for practice prior to the Games – one Day free for all skaters.

The Games will be held as per RSFI rules and will be conducted by Technical officials of RSFI.

4. Entry:

The 3rd INDIA SKATE GAMES 2026 Entry to be done online. Please go to the website WWW.INDIASKATE.COM and register with your RSFI Annual Registration Number. Make Payment Online. After completing the Entry online, take a printout of the entry form. One copy of the hard copy of Entry to be submitted to the Championship office along with DOB Proof & Insurance Copy. Participation in All India Open/National Ranking/National Inter district/India Skate Games etc., allowed only with State/UT NOC (NOC should be given by State/UT Unit via Email or Hard copy with entire list of Participants).

Registration Opens on 25th March & Registration Closes on – 20th April 2026

- 5. Skaters Annual Registration:** Only RSFI Annual Registered Skaters are eligible to participate. Those who are not registered for 2026-27, shall register themselves with RSFI. Only then they will be able to do the online entry for participation in the Games.
- 6. Claims:** For National Championship and Open/Invitational All India Tournaments/Ranking/India Games an amount of Rs.5000/- per claim shall be enclosed along with every written claim made to the concerned technical Committee Chief referee. The claim must be made by the Team manager/lady manager within 15 minutes before the start of the event or within 15 minutes after announcement of the result. Without disturbing the schedule and depending on the availability of time and concerned records the 5 Technical Committee/ RSFI shall decide the matter. In case the claim is upheld the fee will be returned.
- 7. MINIMUM PARTICIPATION / CRITERIA FOR HOLDING THE COMPETITION:** RSFI organized India Games/Ranking/Inter District/All India Open Championships and state/Uts organized State/UT championship the event can be conducted even there is only 1 participant or 2 teams. Ranking will be given on the basis of minimum criteria as per annexure I. Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal shall awarded only if there are three participants, Silver and Bronze Medal if there are two participants and Bronze Medal if there is only single participant subject to the fulfilment of criteria as mentioned in IIRR Annexure – I.
- 8. Liability:** Please note that for any injury/ losses caused to the participants during the above Tournament, on or off the skating/playing area, CRSA/RSFI shall not be responsible and or liable to meet any expenses/damages whatsoever. Therefore, all participating skaters are to take adequate accidental, medical and life insurance policies. They are to carry the necessary policies with them.
- 9. Uniform / Equipments :** Skaters have to come in proper uniform and with proper equipment for respective events i.e Speed Skating, Artistic Skating, Roller Hockey, Inline Hockey, Inline Freestyle Skating, Skateboarding, Inline Alpine, Downhill, Roller Scooter, Roller Freestyle Skating, Roller Derby.

Skaters/Players/Riders will not be permitted to participate in any of the “Roller Sports” events who are not in proper uniform & not having required Safety Gear/Equipment for the discipline in which he/she is participating.

Safety Gear is necessary to guarantee their safety. Any skater/Rider/player taking part in Games shall be responsible for his/her own safety. Participants compete at their own risk. Any injuries/losses caused to the participants during Games/ on or off the playing area, Federation/State/U.T/ District/Club & or Organisers/Host Association and or its officials shall not be responsible and or liable to meet any expenses/damages whatsoever.

Note: For Speed Skating, skin suit is compulsory. The helmet must be a hard gear with certification. The helmet must be well fastened on the head in conformity with the safety instructions of the manufacturer. Each skater is solely responsible for ensuring that his/her personal equipment meets the highest safety criteria in order to obtain the utmost safety of the skater. A skater who removes his helmet before the end of the race shall be disqualified.

10. In case of any unforeseen circumstances the schedule of events are not completed, the decision by RSFI observer and CRSA will be final.

11. GENERAL:

(i).Skaters/s who are not selected or are under suspension or have disciplinary action pending against them, shall not be eligible to participate in the GAMES.

(ii).Skaters are to bring wheels suitable for use on all kind of floors including Asphalt/ Asphalt Coated, Cement - Kota - Cudappa Stone - Tandar Stone - Mosaic - Tarmac - Wooden surfaces etc.

(iii).To uplift the standard of skating and face challenges of international competitions and to discourage substandard skaters, Judges and referees at the GAMES may introduce Elimination round/ Qualifying Time/ Points /Marks/ Conduct Skating tests for allowing participation in the Games. Skaters found substandard will not be allowed participation e.g. All Hockey players must perform skating and basic hockey skill at the start of Hockey match before Games referee/s in charge.

If the skater is found to be substandard then he/she will not be eligible to participate.

(iv).It is suggested that the U.T/State Associations appoint a Lady official for the Girls team and also a Physio or any medical attendant for the team players.

The Team Manager appointed for the U.T/State team should be able to maintain a code of conduct during the Games, as we have seen in past, inappropriate conduct towards judges, officials, Organisers and other participants Parents & coaches of the skaters.

In case of unacceptable behaviors, the concerned athlete/skater/player will be liable of facing a penalty & disqualification.

(v). Disrespectful (e.g. sexual, violent, insulting) movements or gestures, especially towards the judges or during Opening/Closing/Medal ceremony, are not appropriate and the skater can be penalised or disqualified.

(vi).Dope/Drug Test: may be carried out at random on players to ensure drug/ dope are not used by them to enhance performance. Anti Doping Rules of NADA is applicable to all participants. Please see RSFI website in this regard. All Skaters shall be ready any time for Dope Test.

Anti-Doping Rules of National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) is applicable to all participants. The players can be medically examined by the concerned agencies or any other agency advised by the government CRSA/RSFI/WS/WSA at any point of time. The CRSA/RSFI may ask for necessary medical certificate/s in this regard from any player at any point of time. Expenses, if any in this regard are to be borne by the concerned skater/s.

(vii).Managers /Coaches Meeting: will be held between 5 to 7 p.m. on the day of reporting to discuss arrangements made for The Games/ Clarification of Rules/ Announcement of program/ and the Games Schedule etc. Respective RSFI Technical Committees proposes to conduct clinics for participating team coaches/managers.

(viii).Accident/Medical/Life/Insurance Policies: Please note that for any injuries/losses caused to Participants/Officials / accompanying members during Games / on or off the playing area, RSFI and or Organisers / Host Association and

or its officials shall not be responsible and or liable to meet any expenses / damages whatsoever. All the participating skaters, officials and accompanying members must take adequate accidental, medical and life insurance policies. They are to carry the necessary policies with themselves. Every team must carry First Aid Kit.

(ix). Minimum Qualifying timing/points/marks for CERTIFIACTE:

>Speed Skating, there is a minimum timing criteria as under.200mts rink timing in Seconds Minimum qualifying time for National Quads: 6-8 (38), 8-10 (35), 10-12 (33), 12-15(30), 15 - 18 (28) & Above 18 (26) (Seconds).

Inline: 6 to 8 (37), 8-10 (34) 10-12 (32) 12-15 (29), 15 -18 (27) & Above 18 (24) (Seconds).

>Artistic Skating Skater must Perform All four basic edges one leg turns, two leg turns, recognized jumps and basic spins, also skaters should have proper attire.

>Roller & Inline Hockey, please send only deserving skaters in the team. Do not add below standard skaters to fill up the empty places in the team.

Skaters need to have basic skills of Roller & Inline Hockey & they must clear the Basic framework of the skills which include Forward & Backward Skating, Braking, Dodging, Shooting and Ball/puck control. Also both Roller & Inline Hockey skaters should have proper kit & safety equipment to participate.

>Inline Freestyle Skating: For Classic Slalom, skater must perform all four basic edges one leg turns and Perform a variety of slalom tricks that include sitting, spinning, wheeling and other tricks, etc.

For Speed Slalom event there is a minimum timing criteria as under for 20 cones Minimum qualifying time for National: 10 -12 (7.0), 12-15 (6.5),15- 18 (6.0) & Above 18(5.5) (Seconds).

In case any player/team fails to clear the technical round conducted by technical committee, can be disqualified at any given point of time.
